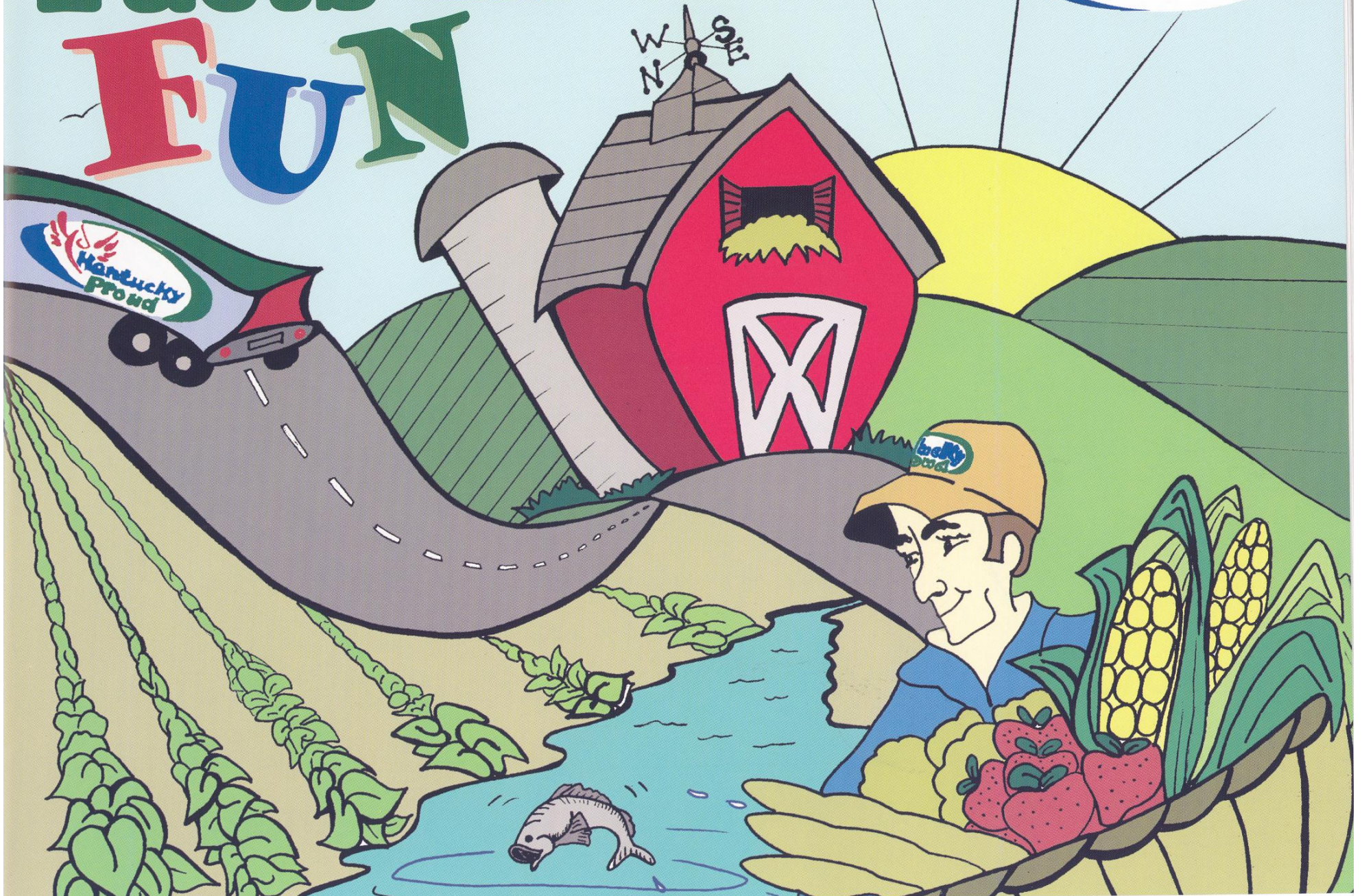

3 = Green



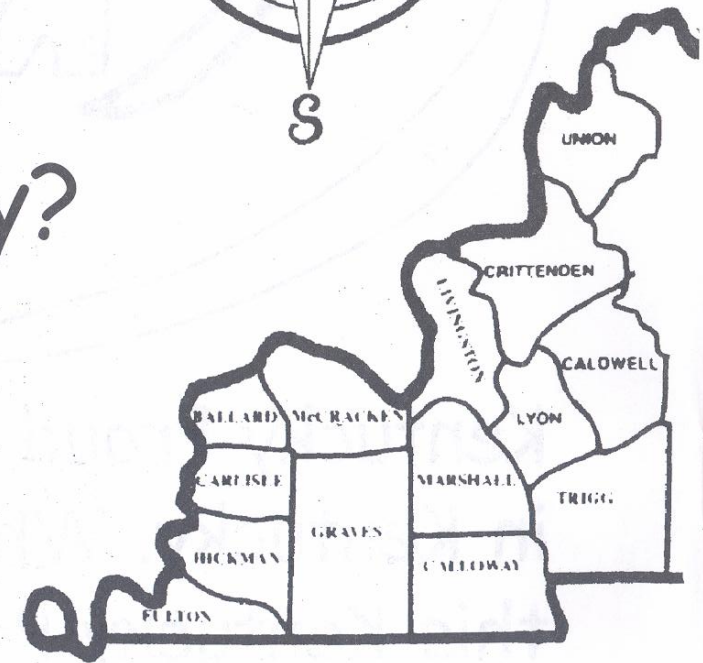
Kentucky Proud means the food you eat is grown in Kentucky. When you go to the grocery, look for this Kentucky Proud sign on the foods you like!

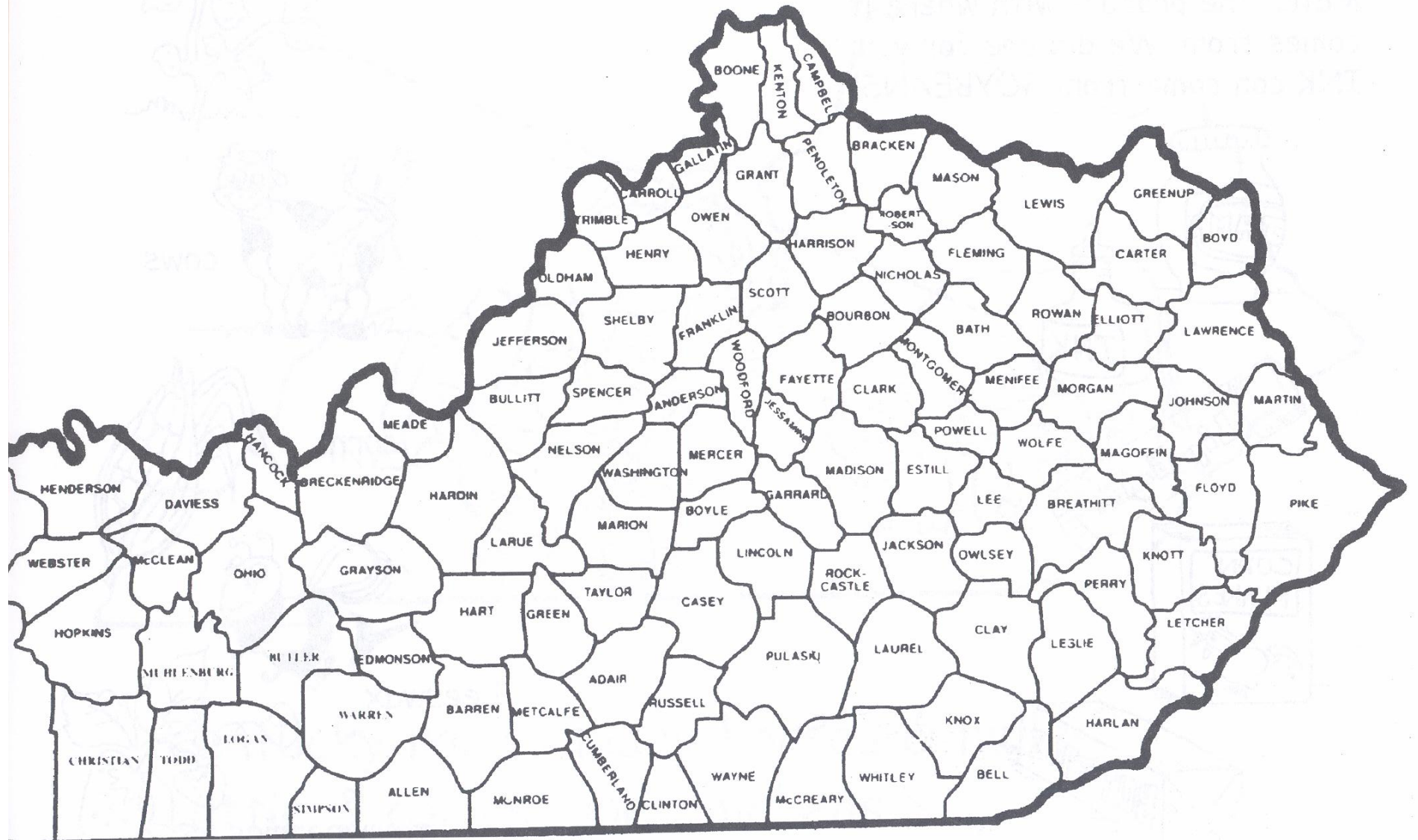

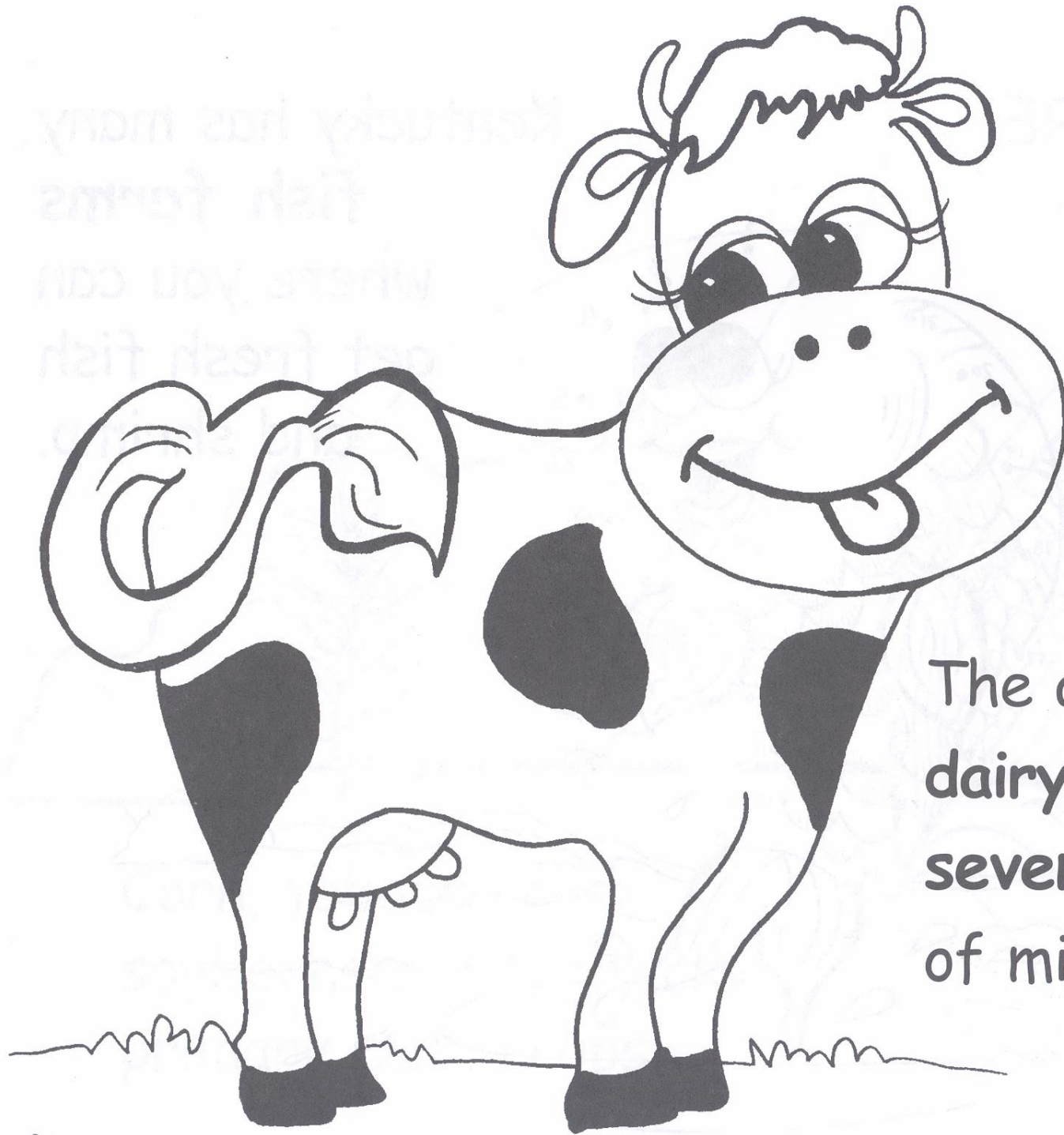


Corn, tobacco and soybeans are Kentucky's primary cash crops.

and shrimp.





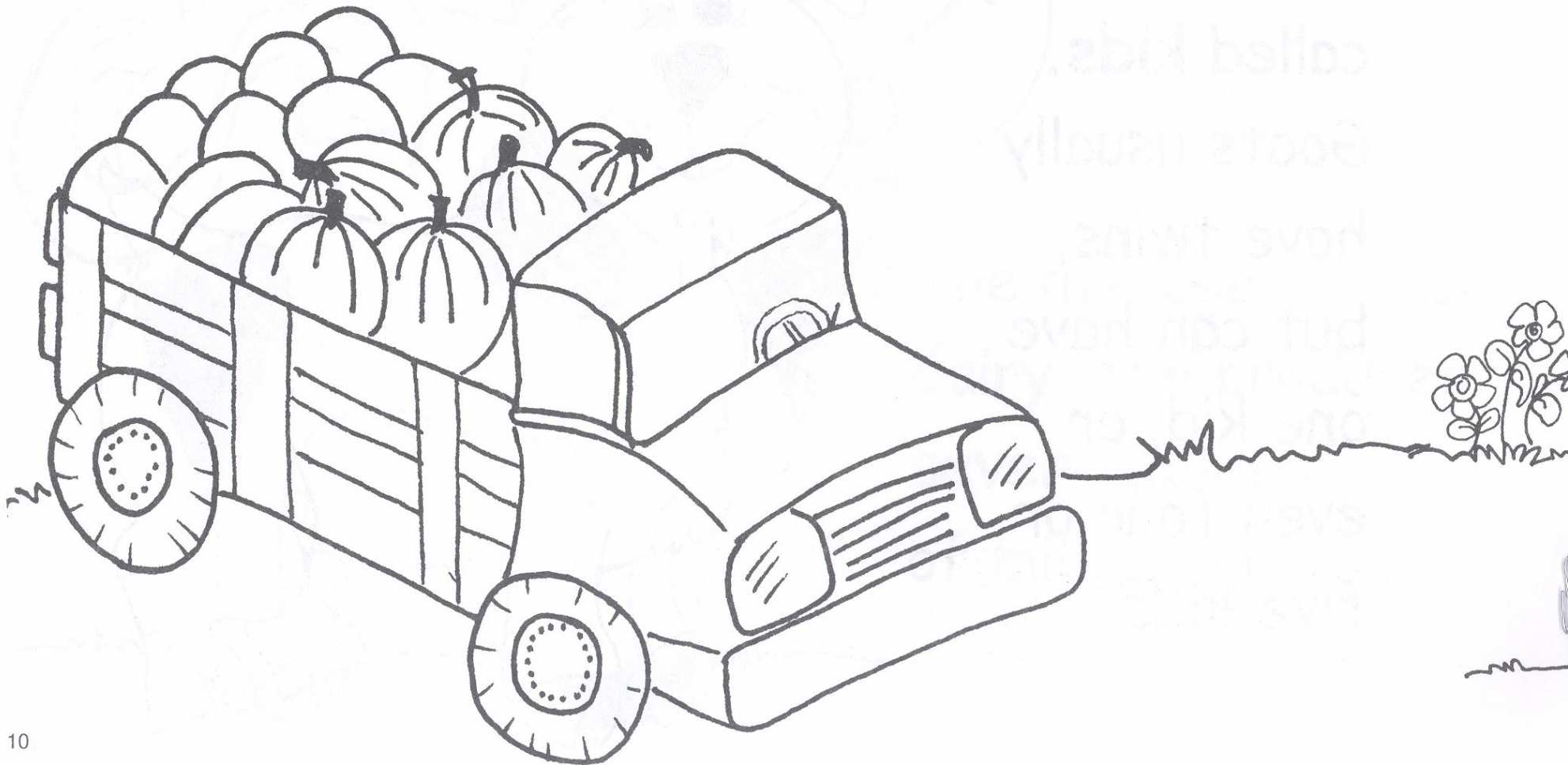
The average

of milk each day.

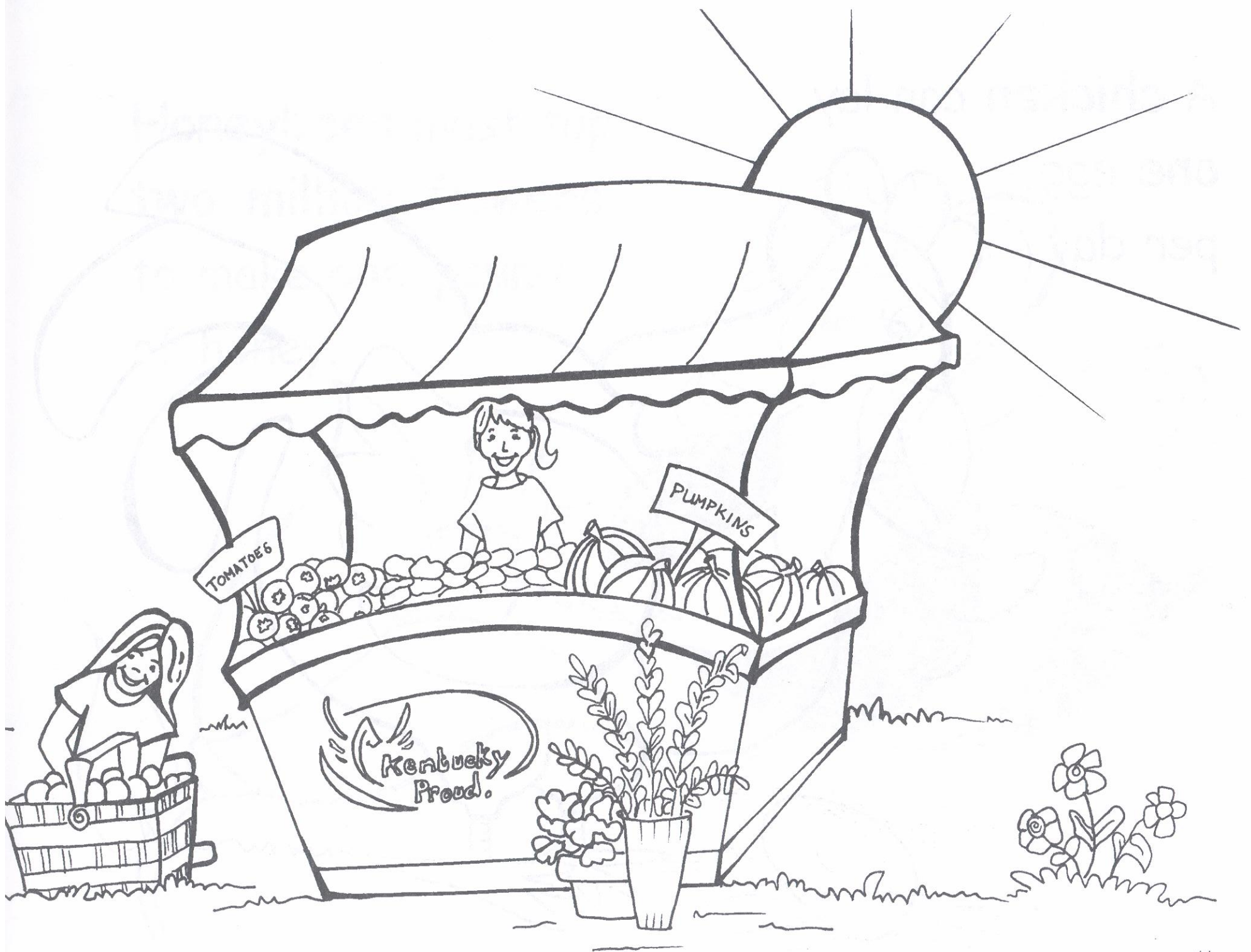
Kentucky is one of the fastest growing states for **goat** production in the U.S.

Baby goats are called **kids**. Goats usually have twins, but can have one kid, or even four or five kids.

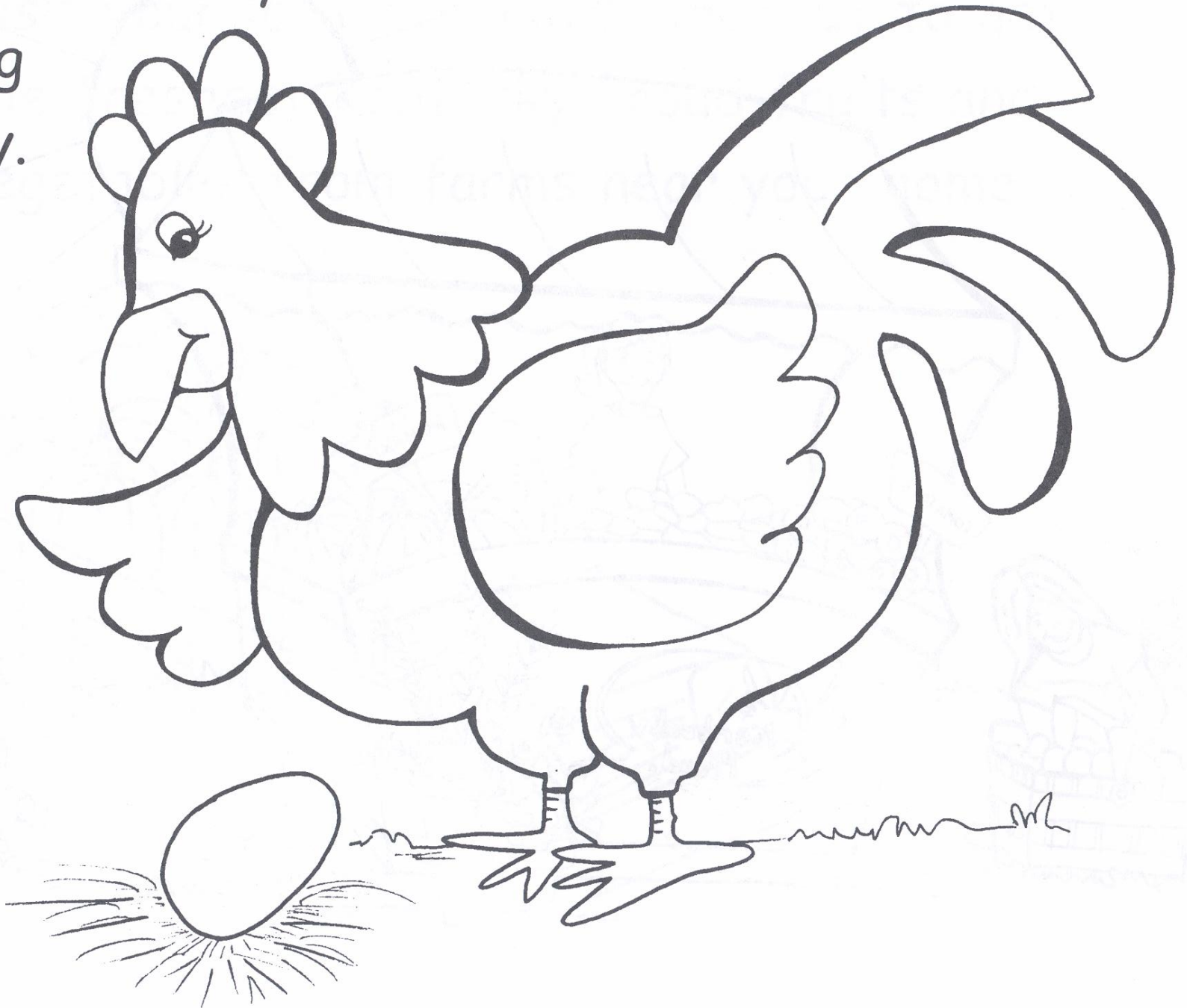

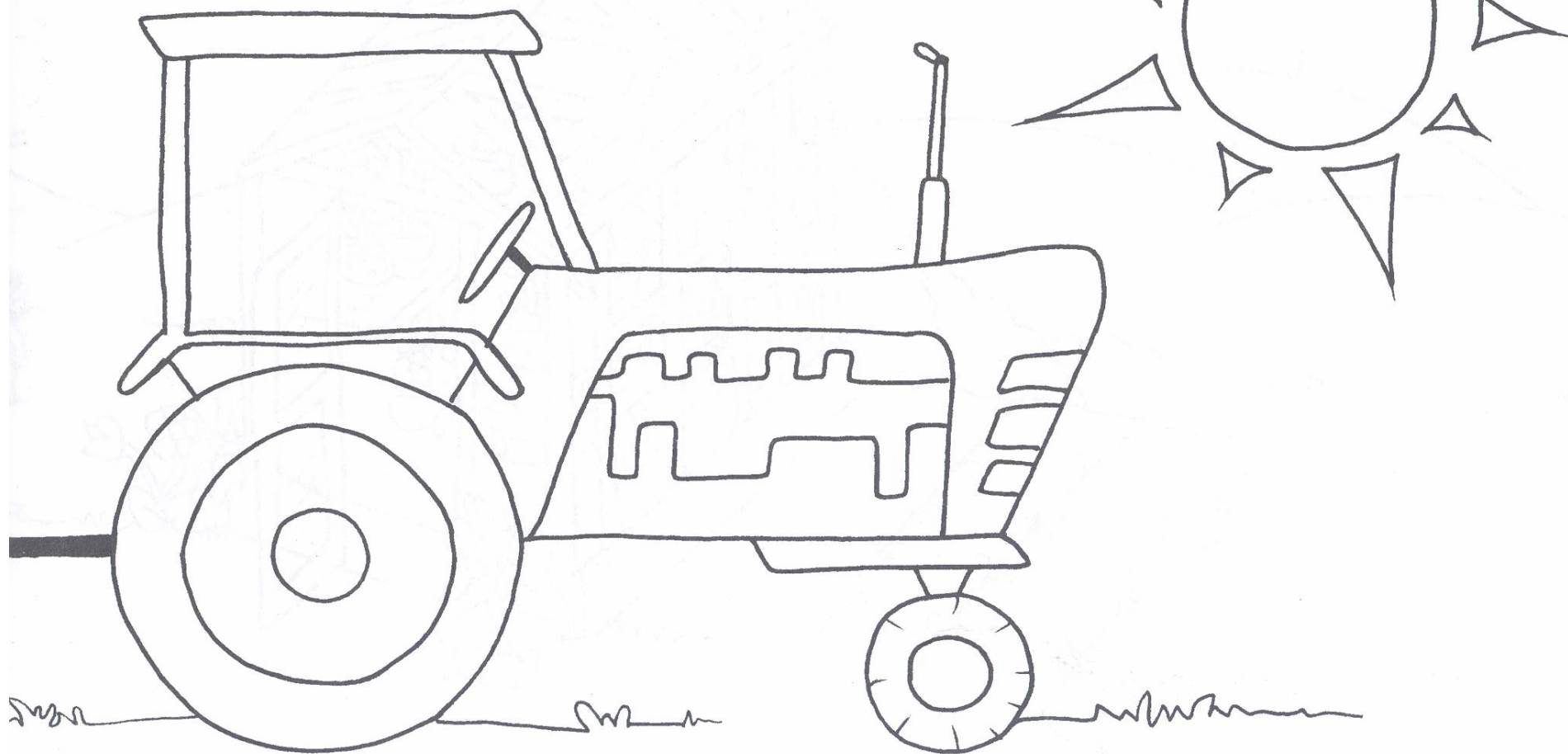
# AGRITOURISM

participate in feeding animals and

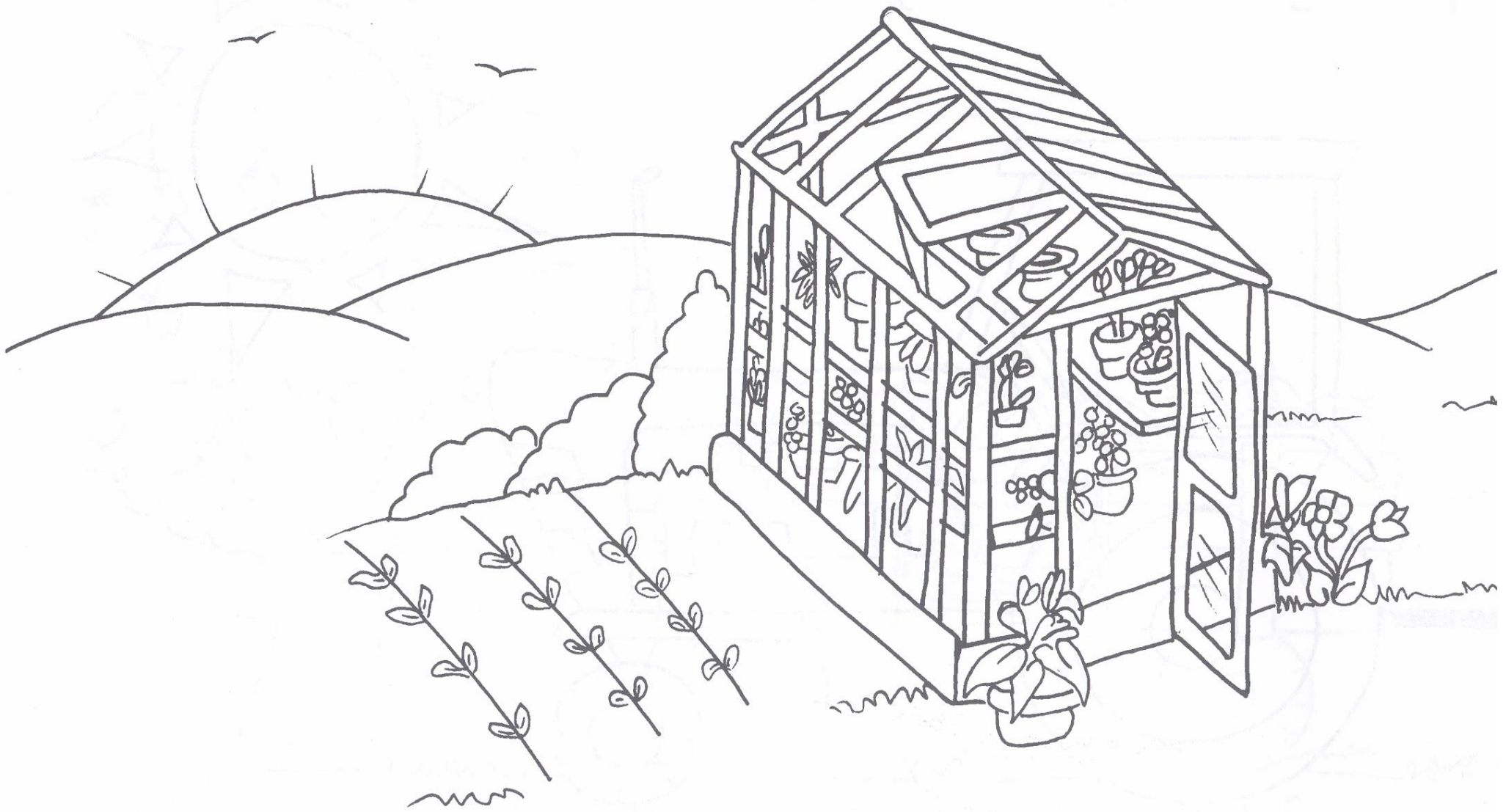


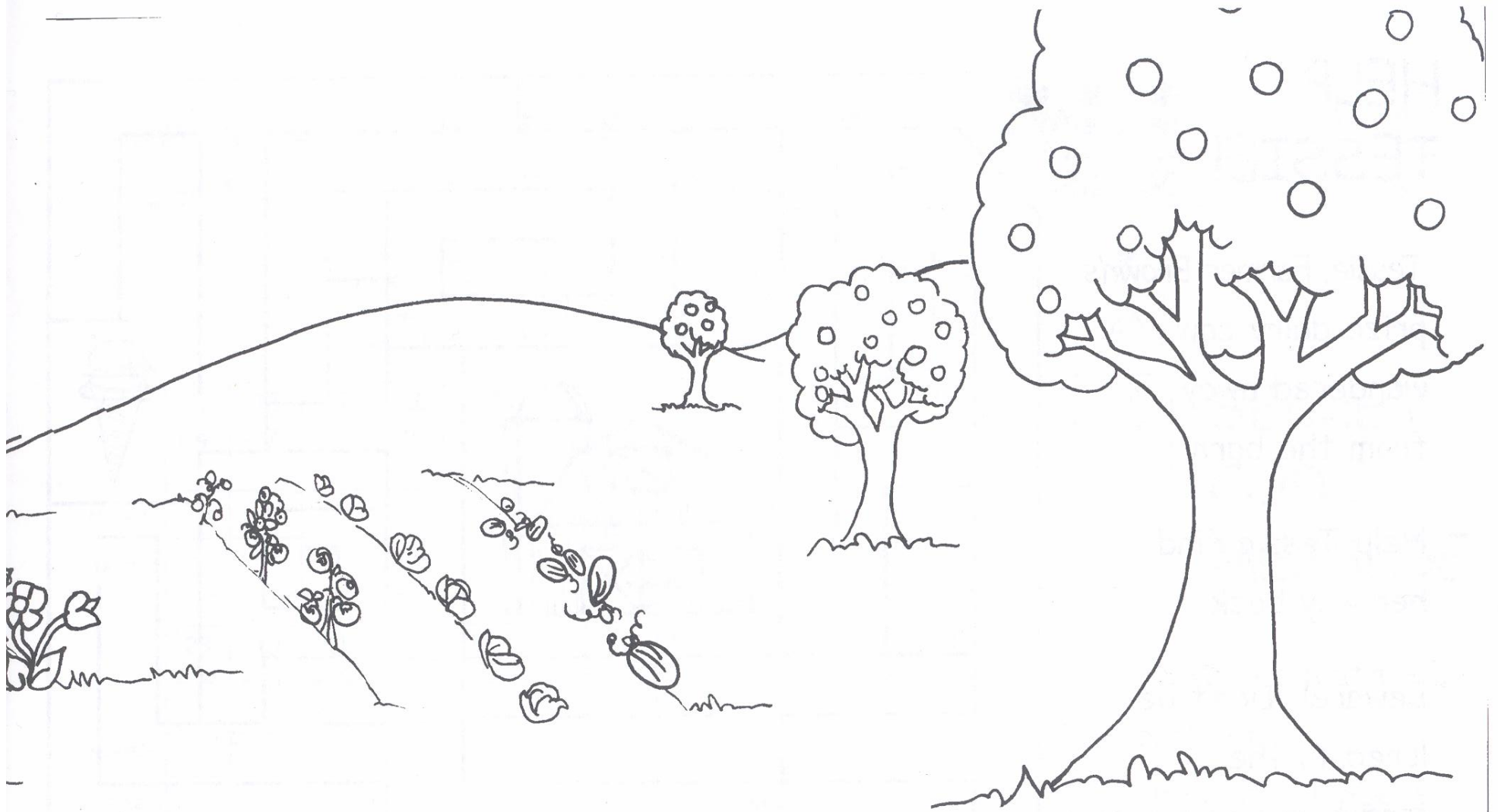

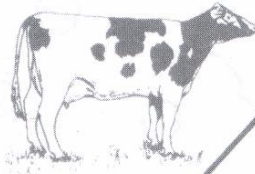
# HORTICULTURE





Kentucky farmers raise vegetables, fruits, flowers, and trees for our enjoyment. Many farmers use **greenhouses** to raise their plants and produce.

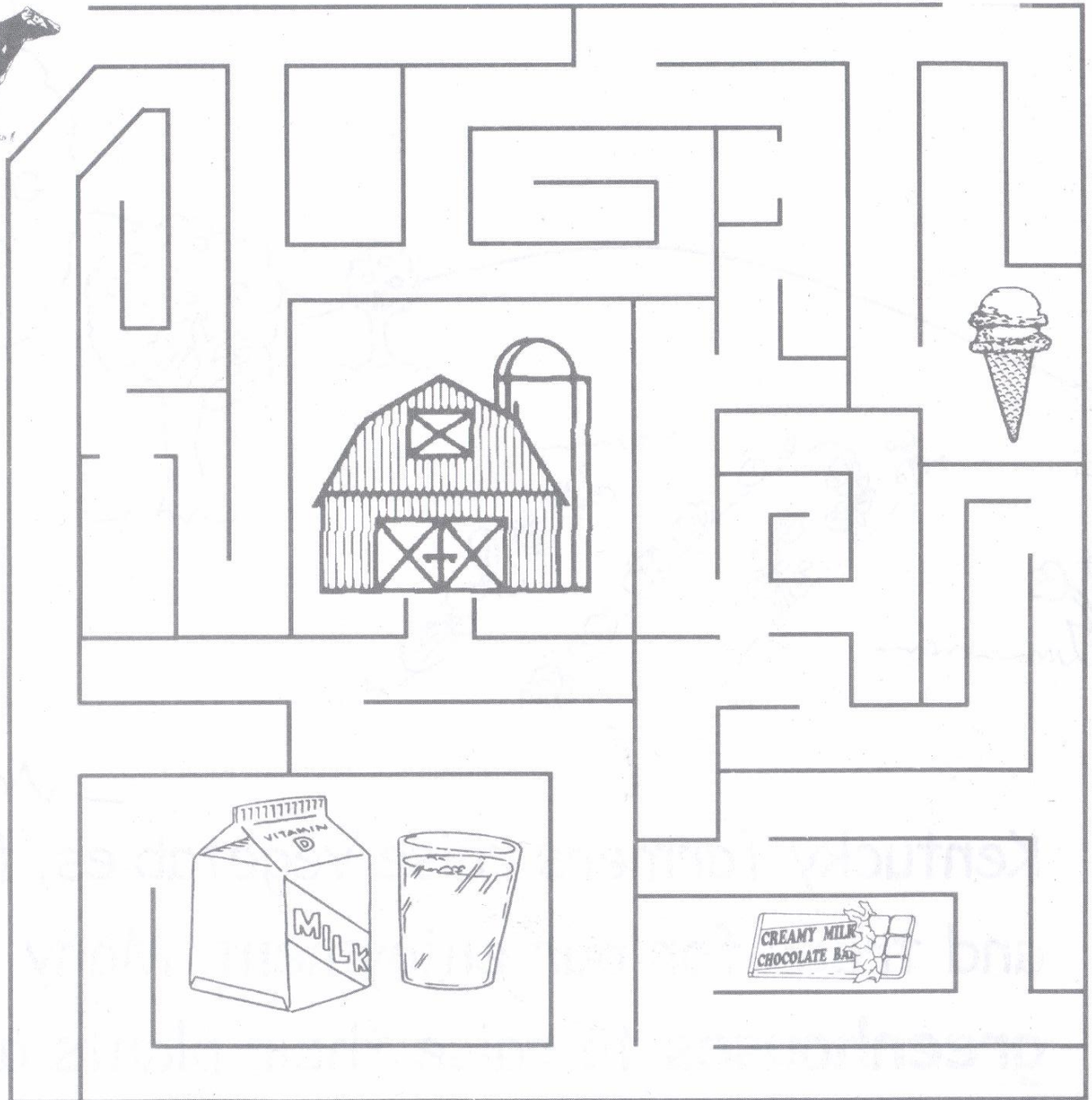
# HELP TESSIE!

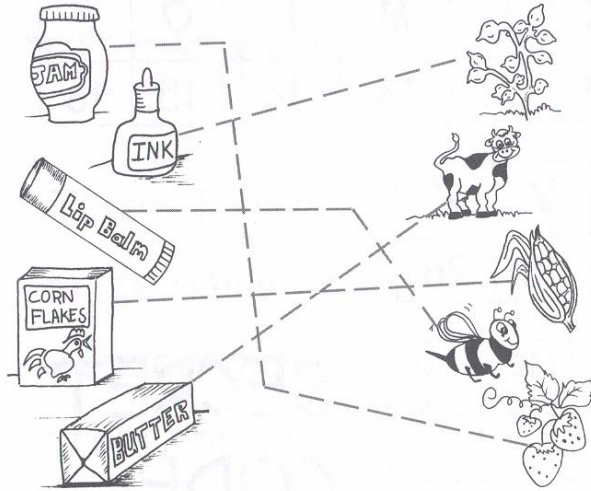

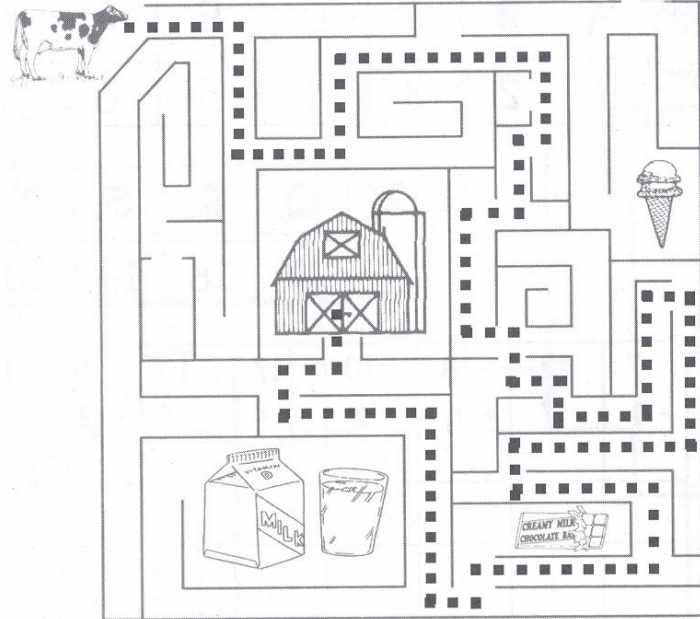
