

# **ADMINISTRATIVE HOLD ON BULK GROUND BEEF – A594**

Most of you have probably seen or at least heard about this HOLD last night or this morning on the news. This HOLD is only on BULK GROUND BEEF – A594.

It does affect two Commodity Processing companies in the State of Kentucky – Advance Food Company and Culinary Standard. This is not a reflection on these companies as they were not the growers or producers of the A594 in question; this is product that was bought by USDA for distribution to commodity processors in the National School Lunch Program.

This HOLD only affects schools that had end-product produced by either company. If your agency processed with either company and have product in your schools, please complete the attached form and send to Ann Smith at [Ann.Smith@ky.gov](mailto:Ann.Smith@ky.gov) by **noon on Friday, February 1, 2008.**

We will provide more information as it is made available to us from USDA.

The following is directly quoted from the information we received from USDA:

“We received news yesterday of serious allegations concerning the treatment of cattle at Westland Meat Company, a slaughter facility. For your information, AMS immediately suspended Westland Meat as a supplier to USDA yesterday (Jan. 30) and placed an administrative hold on all products in or destined for Federal food and nutrition programs. Anyone who received beef from this plant received an email, phone call, and/or fax last night until confirmation was received in this office that the message was delivered. Red meat processors were also notified last night. States that backhaul fine ground beef in 40 lb cases for reprocessing should notify their processors of the hold immediately.”

More to follow, but that is what we have managed to do since finding out yesterday.
