

INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS AMUSEMENT RIDES AND ATTRACTIONS

KRS 247.234 and 302 KAR 16:010 requires liability insurance to be on file with the Kentucky Department of Agriculture PRIOR to issuance of a permit to operate. You are also required to have a copy of your insurance certificate available for our inspector(s) to review.

Listed below are insurance requirements:

Insurance Company name on certificate which is authorized to issue such policy in this state according to KRS 247.234, C.

Minimum amount of \$500,000 for Mobile Operators and \$500,000 for Permanent Sites, as prescribed by KRS 247.234, Section 2, Paragraph C.

Thirty (30) Days Cancellation Notice.

The Certificate Holder must be the Kentucky Department of Agriculture, Division of Regulation and Inspection, 107 Corporate Drive, Frankfort, KY 40601.

Need actual list of amusement rides/attractions with serial numbers on the Certificate, or attached pages.

If policy covers all rides (owned, leased, or booked-in) you **MUST** list the names of Rides and their serial numbers on the Insurance Certificate, (If no serial numbers, Assign your own).

If any exclusions on rides, such as moonwalks, swinging gyms, etc., this must be Stated so on the Insurance Certificate.
