This Consumer Disclosure form is required by Kentucky regulations and approved by the Kentucky Department of Agriculture (KDA) for purposes of informing you, the consumer, of wood destroying organism (WDO) procedures and protection. This Consumer Disclosure is not the contract or service agreement for the WDO treatment. You should read and understand the contract or service agreement for the WDO treatment before treatment is performed. A drawing showing areas of WDO activity and other information should be attached. Carpenter ants and carpenter bees are not required to be included in this Consumer Disclosure.

It is difficult to predict how long it will take to control a WDO infestation and it is not unusual for a treatment to take several months or more to be effective. Variables such as construction type, extent of infestation, weather and soil conditions, and type of treatment may influence the time required to achieve control. Results are enhanced when there is cooperation between the property owner and the Pest Management Professional (PMP). If you have any questions regarding this Consumer Disclosure or your WDO treatment, contact your PMP or the KDA.

If this WDO treatment is a Termite Baiting Program, it should be understood that there is no protection from termites once the baiting system is removed. If this is a Conventional or Partial Termite Treatment, protection from termites may be reduced if less than the labeled amount of termiticide is used.

The customer should understand that hidden damage may be present but not visible at the time of treatment, new damage may occur before the WDO treatment takes effect and reinfestation may occur requiring additional treatment. Any pre-existing damage visible on the date of treatment shall be shown on the completion graph for the WDO treatment.
