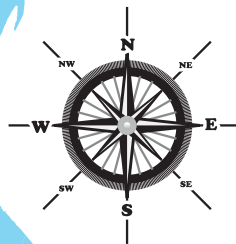

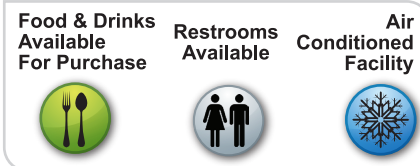

We began years ago when our three daughters participated in the KY State Horse Program through the Campbell County 4-H Saddle Up Club. They rode in three disciplines: western, English, and contest. During that time we raised a few foals and then began a breeding program with a gray quarter horse stallion we had raised. Our goal is to raise quality performance quarter horses for show and sale along with quality alfalfa hay. We raise one or two foals a year. We will be doing a 15-20 minute on ground training demo at 11 AM and 1 PM with both young and seasoned horses.

Flagg Spring Ranch is a 530 acre farm owned by the Haas family. This farming operation has a strong focus on natural resources conservation. By protecting the soil and water resources, Flagg Spring Ranch has improved the productivity of the land that sustains their feeder calf (beef cattle), hay, pasture and woodland operation. During this tour stop you will see: cattle, hay harvesting equipment, a variety of hay crops (eastern gamma grass and switchgrass) and conservation practices that will include stream crossing, fencing out streams, livestock watering systems and mud control.

RULES OF THE ROAD:

Thirteen diverse farms have opened their gates for you to experience local agriculture first-hand. Take this opportunity to meet local farmers, taste farm-fresh food, learn stewardship and farm skills from experts, and explore the fields of local farms.

- No admission for the Farm Tour.
- Plan ahead! Check out each farm description in the brochure to determine what farms you'd like to see. The Farm Tour is not designed to visit every location.
- Dress for a farm visit, wear sturdy shoes that can get dirty and bring all-weather clothing.
- Be aware and considerate of farm animals. Follow the farmers' instructions and wash your hands after handling animals.
- DO NOT bring pets with you on the tour. Farm animals may be frightened by strange animals, even well trained pets, and this can lead to dangerous situations. These are working farms with animals – please be respectful.
- Many of the farms will have food and beverages for sale and most will have handicapped restrooms available.
- BRING A COOLER so you can purchase farm fresh produce, freezer beef and more items that will be available at some of the farms.
- Ask a volunteer for a farm tour survey to help us count attendance and share your feedback. Future farm tours depend on this information.
- Have fun and bring a sense of adventure. Don't forget your camera.
