India's economy is the fourth largest economy in the world according to GDP, and is projected to grow 8% in 2010, making it the world's fastest-growing economy. India's food and grocery market is the sixth largest in the world, valued at US\$182 billion.

With a population of 1.2 billion, food accounts for two-thirds of the total retail market in India. The retail food sector made up US\$70 billion in 2008, and is expected to grow to US\$150 by 2025.

Companies that are planning to participate in the Outbound Mission to India in September are especially encouraged to attend the IFDE show in order to maintain and follow up with buyer interest generated during the fall mission. Likewise, exporters who were unable to travel earlier will find this event a useful venue to present their products to the expanding Indian marketplace.
