## Background and Acknowledgments

This publication is partially a product of a broad-based initiative to develop local and direct meat marketing enterprises for Kentucky producers and consumers. An informal group known as the “Safe Meat Marketing Alternatives through Research and Technology - SMMART” group, with the support of Partners for Family Farms, identified the need for such a directory and has partially supported the survey and publication with grant funds provided through the Kentucky Department of Agriculture.

The SMMART Group includes farmers, consumers, and staff from the Kentucky Department of Agriculture, Kentucky State University, the University of Kentucky and other state and federal organizations.

In addition to the authors, Ms. Karen Pulliam developed the web-based format.

## Understanding and Using the Directory of Kentucky Livestock Processing Facilities

In recent years there has been an increasing interest in direct and local sales of meat, as an attempt to increase farm revenues and provide alternatives to consumers. A survey of small scale processing facilities was conducted to determine their locations and estimate potential within Kentucky; the objective was to better understand local processing opportunities for farmers.

Previously, there has been little information available on small processing facilities. Since many farmers are trying to find places to slaughter and process their livestock, a telephone survey was performed. Two lists were combined to provide a list of federally inspected meat facilities and a list of “exempt” operations. In total, there are 177 businesses included on these two lists, however, only a minority actually provide slaughtering and processing services. Approximately 58 firms out of the 177 facilities slaughter and process, of those firms, only 19 do so under federal inspection. The remaining 39 are classified as “Kentucky Exempt Plants.”

The difference between federal inspection and “exempt” plants is important. **All** plants must meet sanitation guidelines and be regularly inspected. However, the “exempt” facilities do not have the same level of requirements as the federally inspected facilities. The “exempt” plants are allowed to provide “custom” services. Examples include processing for a farm family’s home use as well as sales of animals on a live basis directly to consumers for their own personal consumption. This includes sales of beef sides and quarters and of whole hogs, lambs and goats. In comparison, federally inspected businesses have the animals **and** the meat inspected which, under Kentucky laws, allows them to sell their products to consumers through retail or food service outlets. Producers who want to sell cuts of meat, frozen or fresh, or processed meat products, must

have their livestock processed under federal inspection. This applies to all sales, even direct sales.

The survey revealed that Kentucky has a weekly slaughter capacity of about 1,000 cattle. Although the survey focused on cattle, there is substantial capacity to slaughter other species. There is a broad range of charges, which is broken down into two parts: 1) Slaughter and 2) Cutting and processing. Slaughter charges range from \$0 to \$50 per head, those with no slaughter fees typically charge more for cutting, processing, and wrapping. These charges range from \$.16 to \$.30 per pound, on a “hanging” or carcass weight basis. A typical charge for these services in the state would be \$22 for slaughtering and \$.23 per pound for processing, which is \$150 to \$175 per steer or heifer. Because disposal costs for offal have been increasing dramatically, the slaughter cost at many facilities may have increased since the survey data were collected.

It is important to note that these prices are average prices and that some facilities may charge more for specialized services. Smoking, specialty cutting, double wrapping, etc. are just a few of the various services that could increase the cost of processing. Therefore, individuals should be aware that these services are available, but only at certain facilities and at a higher price.

Another critical aspect of Kentucky’s processing sector is the wide variability in types of operations. With so many facilities providing so various levels and types of services, it is difficult to specify all processing resources within a given area without making individual contacts with business managers.

This directory should be considered a starting point for those interested in the meat processing industry. This is a dynamic industry that is

continually changing, therefore this information is subject to change as well. This directory will be updated regularly on the UK Agriculture Economics Department's website at <http://www.uky.edu/Ag/AgEcon/> as well as the Direct and Local Meat Marketing project website at <http://www.uky.edu/Ag/KyMeat>.

### **Using the Directory**

This directory is intended to be an easily resource. The majority of the directory is a table, with each firm (along with the pertinent data) listed in alphabetical order. Those who already

know the name of the firm will easily locate them in the alphabetical listing. Those who are interested in finding listings for a specific geographic area have two aids. One is the listing by county and the other is the map. The county listing provides names of firms operating in each Kentucky county, which can then be found in the table. The map uses letters to identify federally inspected operations and numbers to identify custom exempt plants. These map identifiers are shown in the first column of the table. Finally, a map showing the leading livestock producing counties is included to help those who are interested in comparing the location of processing facilities with the most intensive production areas.

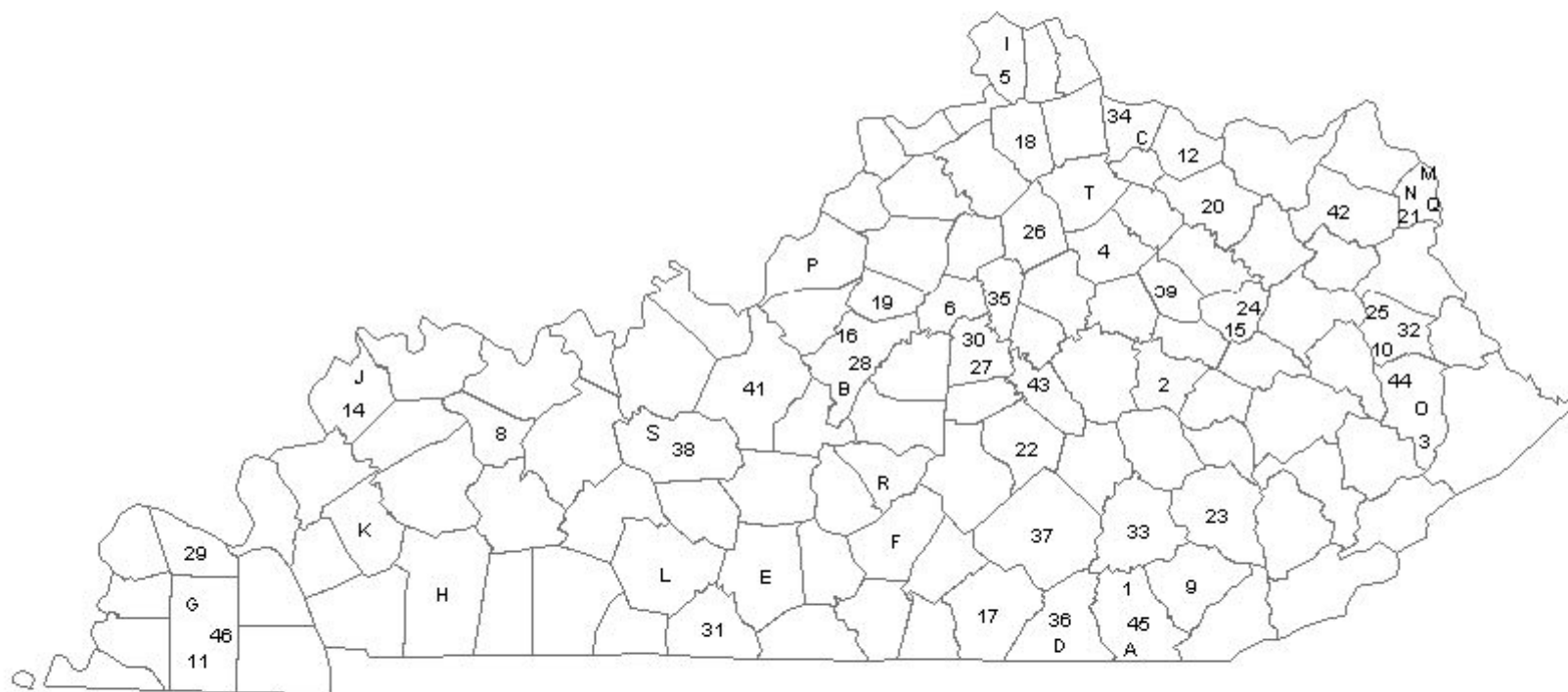

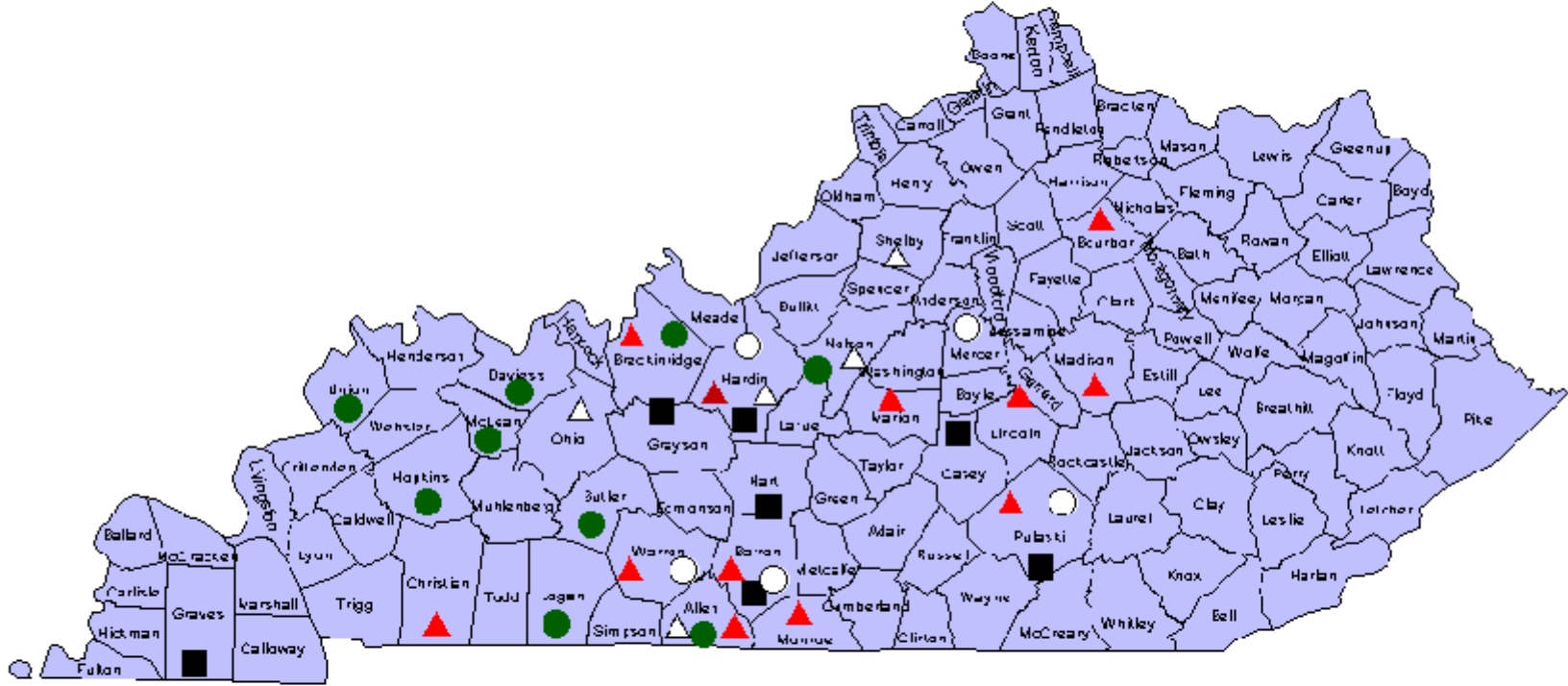
