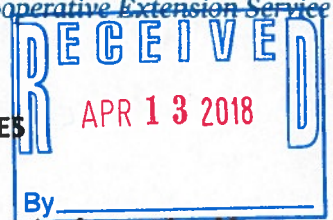

ADAIR COUNTY FARMER'S MARKET ASSOCIATION GUIDELINES

- 1. Membership**
Only growers residing in Adair County with produce grown in Adair County. A Vendor Application for membership must be filled out before a vendor can participate.
- 2. Fees**
\$50 for 2018 season; or
\$10 per visit 2018 (Tuesdays and Fridays)
- 3. Location**
Adair County Cooperative Extension Service parking lot located at 409 Fairground Street in Columbia.
- 4. Days and Hours of Operation - Advertised starting times will be:**
Starting June 15, 2018
Tuesday Mornings 6:00 am – 10:00 am
Friday Mornings 6:00 am – 10:00 am
Setup may occur any time prior to starting time.
- 5. Spaces will be provided on a first come/first served basis.**
- 6. Produce shall be priced and sold by bunch, ear, dozen, bushel peck, etc., or otherwise sold by use of a scale provided by the seller.**
- 7. All sellers will be responsible for their own garbage receptacles, will clean up their own selling space, and will remove their garbage at the end of the selling day.**
- 8. Items for sale are:**
 - ▶ Fresh produce
 - ▶ Jams, jellies, breads, fruit pies, cakes and cookies – vendor must be registered with the Cabinet for Health Services and proof must be provided.
 - ▶ Other canned goods – vendor must be registered with the Cabinet for Health Services and certified as a Home-based Microprocessor. Proof must be provided.
 - ▶ Eggs – clean, candled, new cartons – must meet KY Cabinet of Health guidelines.
 - ▶ Flowers, bedding and potted plants may be sold.

**** Vendor must provide proof of meeting all KY Cabinet of Health requirements and USDA inspections to the Adair County Cooperative Extension Service. ****

- 9. No live animals of any type may be sold.**
- 10. Locally grown meat can be sold if USDA inspected; vendor needs a permit to sell USDA inspected meat. No fish or shrimp products.**
- 11. Pricing will be determined by the seller.**
- 12. Neither the Adair County Farmer's Market Association or the Adair County Cooperative Extension Service is responsible for any accidents or theft. You operate at your own risk.**

Failure to meet these guidelines will result in a vendor being asked to vacate the premises.

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
