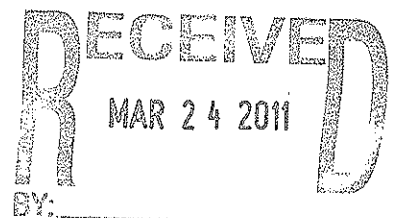


## 2011 Breckinridge County Farmers' Produce Market Guidelines

- Open every Saturday (provided produce is available) starting June 25<sup>th</sup> from 6:30 am (CT) until sold out.
- Open every Tuesday (provided produce is available) starting July 5<sup>th</sup> from 3:00 pm (CT) until sold out.
- Participants must have a farm and raise some produce in Breckinridge County
- No Out of County participants
- Any sellers not in compliance with the regulations will be given:
  - First – a warning
  - Second – will be asked to vacate the premises.
- Prices must be posted at opening time and can be adjusted and reposted ASAP
- First Come-First Serve for vehicles. Space may be assigned to each member, if dispute occurs
- Must attend initial opening meeting or will cost \$10.00 per setup in parking lot
- Participants must be trained by Ag Agent before accepting WIC vouchers and SR FMNP vouchers for produce and signs posted to that effect.
- Types of produce to be sold:
  - Produce that is clean and of excellent quality.
  - All fruits, vegetables and herbs.
  - Baked goods are **NOT** allowed (includes bread, cakes, pies).
  - **No** live animals, fresh meat, fish, milk or milk products.
  - **NO** SAMPLES – WITHOUT TRAINING
- Produce must be kept off the ground in containers.
- Produce shall be priced and sold by bunch, ear, dozen, bushel, peck, etc. or otherwise sold by use of a certified scale.
- It is the participant's responsibility to know the price of products being sold.
- No spoiled produce will be offered for sale.
- Quality and freshness are the two key selling points for the grower.
- Produce offered for sale must meet the required amount of days since last spraying of pesticides. Pesticides include all herbicide, fungicides, or insecticides. For grower's safety, records should be kept so that they can be referred to if a customer asks.
- Must use bags provided.



- Cleanup: All sellers will be responsible for their own garbage receptacle, will clean up their own selling space, and will remove their garbage at the end of the selling day and take it with them or put it in the onsite dumpster. **DO NOT LEAVE ANY PRODUCE ON PREMISES**
- Participants should make sure their truck is free of mud, manure, etc. Image is a big part of the sale.
- Tables will be provided to the members who attend the initial meetings.
- The market will provide bags or proper containers for their customers until supply is gone.
- Participants will display membership sign where it is easily seen.
- A copy of this form and a WIC Voucher program form and SR FMNP program form will constitute membership and the privilege to sell.
- **Breckinridge County Extension Service will be providing inside restrooms if they are kept CLEAN AND NEAT.**
- **ALL children must be under adult supervision at all times.**

I, the undersigned, have read these rules and regulations governing the Breckinridge County Farmers Market and agree to the above. A violation of the above gives the Breckinridge County Farmers Market members the privilege to sell and revoke the membership privileges, no fees refunded.

I will not hold the Breckinridge County Extension Office personnel or the property owners responsible in the event of an accident in connection with the operation of the Breckinridge County Farmers Market.
