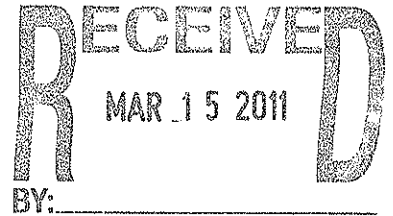
Location: Estill County Fairgrounds (under the pavilion)

Season: May 24 through October 26, 2011

Days and hours of operation: Tuesdays 3-7 pm

Fridays 8 am - 1 pm

Senior Day 2nd Monday of each month
10 am -2 pm



Rules

-Membership is open to Estill County residents and to growers in surrounding counties upon approval. Annual membership is \$30 per household or \$5 per day. Payment must be made before set-up.

.-The ECFMA will meet on the fourth Wednesday of each month (except November & December) at 7 pm in the extension office.

-All sellers, sellers guests and family members are expected to dress and behave in an appropriate manor for dealing with the public.

-Sellers should try to arrive early on sale days to be ready to sell at the official opening time.

-Booth space is provided on a first come first served basis. The seller will provide his or her own tables, displays etc.. and are expected to leave the booth area clean and free of any produce debris and trash. Receptacles will be provided.

-ECFMA requires that 75% of produce sold over the season must be grown by the seller. Every member of the market is subject to a farm check.

-Specialty items may be sold upon approval by a majority of the membership. These items include, but are not limited to, honey, molasses, flowers, nursery stock, herbs and herb by-products, bedding plants, eggs, home baked goods, and home processed jams and jellies, and handcrafted items. (no kits, imports etc.. will be allowed)

-Produce shall be priced and sold by the pound, with the use of state certified scales, or sold by the bunch, ear, dozen, peck etc.. Minimum pricing may be set by a market committee according to current market prices. **There will be no underselling.**

-Prices must be displayed at your booth for all products and each seller must provide suitable packaging for his or her products.

-Produce must be kept off the ground.

-No selling of live animals, fresh meat, fish, milk or milk products.

-No spoiled, damaged or diseased produce may be offered. Quality and freshness are key selling points for a farmers market.

-Sellers must comply with local, state and federal regulations that apply to their products. These include, but are not limited to;

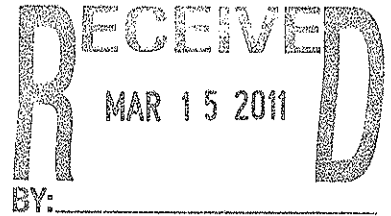
1. Pesticide licensing, their safe use and residue levels.
2. The use of state certified, legal-for-trade-scales. (state inspection seal required).
3. State sales tax collected as required.
4. Certificate of completion of Good Agricultural Practices
5. Certificate of completion of Sampling Education for
6. Proper permits and labeling as required for the sale of jams,

-Seller must agree to comply with these rules. First offense will be a verbal warning. Second offense will require seller to leave and your continued membership will go before the board which may result in expulsion from the association with no refund.

-Market rules will be reviewed periodically and are subject to change. Any changes will be made by majority vote of members.

No Drugs, Alcohol, or firearms are allowed.

Estill County Agricultural Fair Association will not be held responsible for accidents.

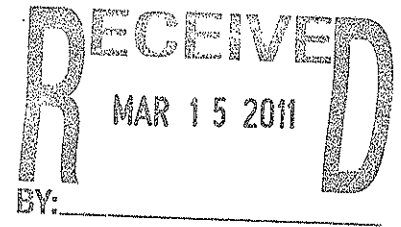
