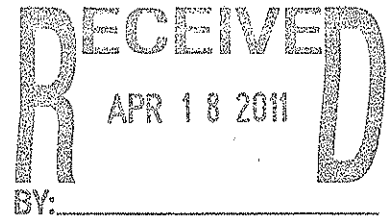

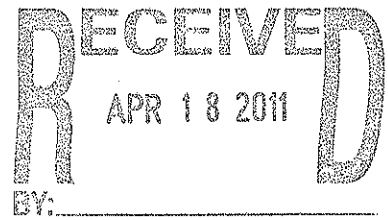

Rules & Regulations**



1. Outdoor Market Hours: Monday & Wednesday 4 - 6pm. Saturday 9 - 1pm.
2. Membership Fees: First time Vendors is \$25.00 lifetime membership.
The market will also receive 25% of all Inside Market Sales.
3. Set-Up Fees for Outdoor Market: Outside Vendors will pay \$50.00 per calendar year.
The Market will also receive 5% of all Outside Sales.
4. Set-Up Time for Outdoor Market: Vendors may arrive and set up 15 minutes prior to start time.
Sales may begin at that time also.
5. Market space is available on first come, first serve basis. Please try to arrive on a timely basis to limit traffic in lot after market begins.
6. Set up of tables and displays will be inside the market square, not between vehicles.
7. Each growers (farm name) shall be prominently displayed at each stand.
8. Prices shall be displayed for all items. This is an absolute necessity if we get the food stamp program.
9. The market will provide new bags for members to use for all customer purchases.
Please see market Manger for supplies.
These bags are for use at this market only.
10. All growers are responsible for his/her display and area. Vehicles, table, tents, canopies, and /or umbrellas should be free of mud, manure, etc. Members shall be properly dressed, which will include clean clothes, shirt, and shoes. Image is a big part of the market.
11. Vendors are responsible for cleaning up their area at the end of the market day. Trash receptacles will be available.
12. No spoiled, or poor quality produce will be offered for sale. Quality and freshness are the two key selling points for the grower. If inferior in quality, price should reflect it.
13. Product liability is the responsibility of the vendor and maintaining insurance is strongly recommended.



Rules & Regulations
Continued

14. 10% Rule: Inside Vendors are allowed to supplement their produce sales by bringing in up to 10% of the produce they offer for sale. The source of these products must be displayed. It must be Kentucky grown. Please see market manager regarding these items prior to sales.
15. The Market Manager and/or Board of Directors, reserves the right to inspect produce at anytime on the market or at the farm.
16. **PROPER CONDUCT IS EXPECTED AT ALL TIMES. VENDORS MUST BE COURTEOUS TO OTHER VENDORS. PROFANITY WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. MEMBERS WHO'S CONDUCT IS DEEMED TO BE CONSISTENT WITH, OR DETRIMENTAL TO THE OBJECTIVES OF THE FARMER'S MARKET, MAY BE EXPELLED. IF YOU HAVE A PROBLEM OR CONCERN REGARDING ANOTHER VENDOR, PLEASE TAKE IT TO THE MARKET MANAGER FIRST. IF IT IS NOT RESOLVED TO YOUR SATISFACTION, YOU MAY ALSO TAKE THE MATTER TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS. CONFRONTATION ON THE MARKET LOT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
17. The Market Manager or Board of Directors may ask a vendor to leave the market site for misconduct, littering, selling prohibited products, or selling from outside the market area.
18. Violations of any regulation may result in suspension of a seller's membership, or in the case of serious or repeat violations, revocation of membership. No refund of membership dues or fees will be made.
19. Report of Daily Sales: It is required that a total of each days sales be reported. We will use an anonymous system, which will just require the date and total of sales. Drop it in the box provided. This will help us to provide information regarding the market.
20. Outside Vendors must grow 100% of what they sell.
21. One Vendor may represent another Vendor for outside sales, non-attending Vendor must still follow market rules.
