



**2011 Robinson Center Farmers Market Rules**

**(Quicksand Volunteer Fire Department Site)**

1. All produce must be locally grown in Breathitt or surrounding counties.
2. A minimum of 50% of the items sold must be produced by the vendor.
3. All vendors will abide by selling times and dates as set forth by Farmers Market Board. Tuesday and Friday 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m., Saturday 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.
4. EBT and Debit card purchases can be made on Tuesday and Friday. Saturday will be for cash only sales.
5. Reimbursement for wooden tokens accepted for food stamp purchases will take place at the Breathitt County Farm Bureau Office on the second and fourth Mondays of each month.
6. Vendors can arrive in sell area at 7:00 a.m. for the 8:00 a.m. opening sale time. No selling outside area will be allowed.
7. All processed foods must be produced by the seller.
8. All items for sale must be displayed off the ground.
9. All Handmade Kentucky crafts are welcome to be sold on any market day.
10. Sellers must provide their own scales (Legal for Trade) and containers.
11. Sellers must clean up their marketing area before leaving each day.
12. Each vendor must pay a \$25.00 annual membership fee per space. Youth educational groups may apply for a single membership with an annual fee of \$25.00
13. All vendors must be courteous to other vendors.
14. No alcohol or profanity allowed.
15. UK Robinson Center is not responsible of accidents and damage or loss of property.
16. Market spaces are assigned.
17. The UK Robinson Center Director has the authority to revoke participation for infractions of any of the rules, without refund of dues.
18. The following items are approved for sale:
