

ROWAN STREET FARMER'S MARKET BY-LAWS

2011

1. Each farmer will follow all the state laws for the SFMNP and the state laws for farmer's markets.
2. Any new members must be voted on by the president and the market coordinator.
3. Each farm will be subject to bi-yearly inspections by the president and the market coordinator. Inspections can be done at any time during the year.
4. Farmers can sell for another farmer as long as the product is labeled as to where it came from and both farmers are members of the Rowan Street Farmer's Market.
5. A farmer may only sell Kentucky grown produce. No other items such as meats, eggs, jams, breads, or crafts will be allowed. Farmers may not buy and resale any item from a terminal.
6. Attendance to every market day is essential. At least two market representatives need to be at the sight each market day. If a farmer is not going to attend the market he needs to ensure the produce makes it to Freddie or Kelly the night before.
6. Each farmer will be subject to a \$100.00 membership fee. This will be used to purchase any and all necessary products to ensure the market runs smoothly, such as ink stamps, postal needs, checking account fees, advertisements, etc. Failure to pay membership dues will be grounds for immediate termination.
7. Any farmer that does not follow the by-laws will be issued a letter of termination as a member of the Rowan Street Farmer's Market. No fees will be refunded upon termination. If a letter is received, it must be signed by the president and the market coordinator.
8. No changes in positions or rules will be made during the market year unless a meeting is called and the market coordinator and president agree upon the changes.
9. All complaints must be in writing and sent to the market coordinator, LaDonna Barrick, 4689 Little Union Road, Taylorsville, Ky 40071. The problem will be solved as fairly and quickly as possible.
