From **Blue Grass Parkway:**

1. Take the Lawrenceburg exit to North 127.
2. Travel 7.2 miles to North Hwy. 151 (turn left across from McDonald's).
3. Travel 151 for 3.4 miles to farm located on right.

From **Louisville (I-64 East):**

1. Take the Graefenburg Exit 148 and travel South toward Lawrenceburg 3.7 miles to farm located on left.

From **Lexington:**
(Two Options)

1. Take Blue Grass Parkway West to Lawrenceburg.
2. Follow directions above from Blue Grass Parkway.

Or

1. From West I-64 take Exit 53A to South 127.
2. Travel 127 South 6.9 miles to North 151.
3. Travel 151 for 3.4 miles to farm located on right.
