### 2026 CAIP Incentive Area Guidelines:

# LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT



These guidelines represent one of 11 incentive areas within the **County Agricultural Incentives Program (CAIP)** to provide Kentucky agricultural producers cost-share assistance on practices that increase net farm income and opportunities to try new/innovative technologies or systems that improve farm efficiency and productivity.

Funded participants shall adhere to all local, state, and federal rules and regulations.

### **Incentive Area Limitations:**

- 1. Self-propelled vehicles/equipment are not eligible for cost-share, including but not limited to pallets, tractors, fertilizer, trucks, chemicals, forklifts, cutters, bobcats, all-terrain vehicles, skid steers, etc.
- 2. Reimbursements for repairs, routine maintenance, beautification/cosmetics, and/or renewal of annual subscriptions are not eligible for cost-share.
- 3. **Beginning in 2010**, all transport equipment was removed as eligible cost-share items from all incentive areas. This exclusion includes trailers, wagons, and carts with the primary function of transportation.

### A. Precision Agriculture

#### **Eligible Cost-Share Items:**

- 1. GPS Monitor/Receiver 75%
- 2. GPS Light Bar/Guidance System 75%
- 3. GPS Yield Monitor 75%
- 4. Spatial Analysis Software/Training (Registration Only) 75%
- 5. Computer GPS Hardware 50%
- 6. Variable Rate Application Control Equipment 75%
- 7. Services related to Spatial Management 75%

## **B.** Animal Data Management

#### **Eligible Cost-Share Items:**

- 1. Scale Head 75%
- 2. Readers (Panels, Loops, Wands, and Portals) 75%
- 3. Management Programs (e.g. DHIA, Farm Business Analysis) 75%
- 4. RFID Tags (e.g. CPH45 tags) 75%
- 5. Carcass and/or Feed Efficiency Data Collection through a KADB approved vendor 75%

## C. Farm Safety

#### **Eligible Cost-Share Items:**

1. Farm Implement Safety: fire extinguisher, lights, PTO cover, replacement tractor seat with belt, signage, sirens, seat belt/rollover bars, safety switches and rollover bar canopies for farm implements only, tractor steps with handrails for safety 75%

Effective: January 1, 2026

- 2. Personal Protective Gear: gloves, dust mask, half/full face respirators, helmets, face shields/accessories (including filter cartridges), forced air pumps/batteries, chaps, metatarsal guards, reflective vest, ear protection, and muffs 75%
- 3. Grain Bin Safety: safety harness & lifeline; grain bin lockout/tag out (LOTO) system 75%

### D. Computer Hardware and Record Management Software

#### **Eligible Cost-Share Items:**

- 1. Software: Accounting, Database/Inventory Management, Tax Preparation, or other recordkeeping/financial management software 50%
- 2. The cost of participation in the Kentucky Farm Business Analysis Program (excluded from renewal of annual subscription exclusion) 50%
- 3. The cost of membership in a producer-owned marketing cooperative 50%

## E. Miscellaneous Equipment

#### **Eligible Cost Share Items:**

- 1. Drones for agricultural purposes the following requirements must be met: 50%
  - a. Have remote pilot certificate;
  - b. Register drone with FAA and display the N-number on aircraft; and,
  - c. CAIP educational component MUST BE related to drone operation for agriculture.
- 2. Field Meters pH, refractometer (Brix-meter), moisture, ERGS, ORP/Oxygen, Sodium, NPK: to monitor nutrients, etc. **75%**

### F. Leadership Development

#### Prerequisites:

Applicant must provide proof of enrollment/acceptance, as well as contact information of the leadership program coordinator

Applicant must provide an invoice/letter from leadership program coordinator and a copy of cancelled check for the full amount of the program

#### Eligible Cost-Share Items:

The cost of tuition for one adult leadership program, up to a maximum of \$1,000 **25%** Eligible programs include but are not limited to the following:

- Leadership Kentucky
- Kentucky Agricultural Leadership Program
- Commodity Organization Leadership Programs (e.g. Kentucky Cattlemen's Leadership Program)
- Kentucky Entrepreneurial Coaches Institute
- Regional Leadership Programs
  (e.g. Leadership East Kentucky or Northern Kentucky Leadership Foundation)
- County Leadership Programs
- County Agricultural Leadership Programs
