KENTUCKY ALFALFA & STORED FORAGE CONFERENCE CONTEST

The Alfalfa & Stored Forage contest is held during the Alfalfa & Stored Forage Conference. The Kentucky Department of Agriculture Forage Marketing Program along with the Kentucky Forage and Grasslands Council hand out certificates to the forage participants that have the Best Alfalfa and the Best Alfalfa/Grass Mix hay. The harvest months include April, May, June, July, August, September, October and November of the previous harvest year.

Requirements & Criteria

- A Kentucky producer that produces their own hay and has it tested through a certified lab. The analysis report must be submitted to Kimberly Field at the Kentucky Department of Agriculture by December 31st.
- Purchased hay is not eligible.
- The two divisions are Alfalfa Hay and Alfalfa/Grass Mix .
- There is no fee to enter into the contest.
- The baled date determines the category month.
- Added together, the highest Crude Protein and Relative Feed Value determines the winner.
- The winner of each category will receive a certificate along with a complimentary registration to the Alfalfa & Stored Forage Conference and featured on the Kentucky Forage and Grasslands Website.
