Cattle slaughter totaled 2.36 million head, down 8 percent from February 2012. The average live weight was up 13 pounds from the previous year, at 1,320 pounds.</p> <p>Pork production totaled 1.78 billion pounds, down 6 percent from the previous year. Hog slaughter totaled 8.59 million head, down 5 percent from February 2012. The average live weight was down 1 pound from the previous year, at 277 pounds.</p> <p>Lamb and mutton production, at 11.5 million pounds, was down 7 percent from February 2012. Sheep slaughter totaled 161,700 head, 2 percent below last year. New Animal Id Rules - March 11th
All intact males and females over 18 months must have to move interstate:

- Official id and health certificate (or Owner-shipper Statement if moving to Fed /state approved stockyards or tagging site -).
- Over 18 months headed directly to slaughter back tag will be sufficient must be killed in 3 days.
- Holsteins and all dairy steers or heifers born after March 11 must have official id.
- Exempt feeder cattle under 18 months of age – to be addressed by separate rule at time to be determined.
- Metal NUES tags free through KDA Animal Health (502) 564-3956.
