RFID Tag Acknowledgement for Livestock Producers

These white RFID tags are provided to cattle producers from USDA and the Kentucky State Veterinarian, for the sole purpose of officially identifying sexually intact, replacement cattle (bulls and females). These tags meet the USDA official ID requirements for interstate movement, and the Animal Disease Traceability program.

The tags are assigned to your National Premise Identification number, and are allocated for use only in cattle on the premises listed below.

- Sharing of official RFID tags with other producers is prohibited.
- Removal of official RFID tags from any animal is a violation.
- Once the producer receives their tags it will be the (**Producer's**) responsibility to report back to the OSV office when tags are placed in the animals within 30 days.
- In order to request additional tags after the first allotment has been received, the producer must fill out the tags applied form, and submit to the OSV. Failure to fill out this form and submission to the OSV will result in no additional tags allocated until the form has been received.

Failure to properly use assigned RFID tag may result in an investigation and issuance of notice of violation.

By signing below, I acknowledge receipt of the official RFID tags assigned to my national premises identification number and agree to take full responsibility for application of the assigned RFID tags to only cattle on the designated premises.
