



## RFID Tag Acknowledgement for Livestock Producers

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the Kentucky Office of State Veterinarian (OSV) are providing producers, free of charge, white official radio frequency identification device (RFID) tags for the sole purposes of officially identifying sexually intact, replacement cattle (bulls and females remaining on the farm).

The tags are allocated to your National Premises Identification Number (NPIN) for use in only cattle located on the premises listed.

Producer receiving RFID tags must adhere to the following:

1. Apply the allocated official RFID tags only to cattle on the listed premises.
2. Do not share official RFID tags assigned to you with other producers.
3. Once applied, it is illegal for the official RFID tag to be removed.
4. Within 30 days of application of RFID tags, complete the tags applied form and submit it to the OSV.

Failure to adhere to the above requirements will result in no additional RFID tags being distributed to your premises and notice of violation with associated penalty fine may be issued.
